# JOY

*Celebrate God with one-another.*

---

*“These things I have spoken to you, that My **JOY** may be in you, and that your **JOY** may be made full. This is My commandment, that you love one another, just as I have loved you.” (John 15:11-12 NAS77 emphasis mine)*

How many times have you heard someone declare that they prayed for patience and all hell broke loose? In fact, if there is any one prayer sure to be answered, it is this one. Why? because it is the easiest for God to demonstrate that you have no patience.

Unfortunately, people are so interested in gaining a godly

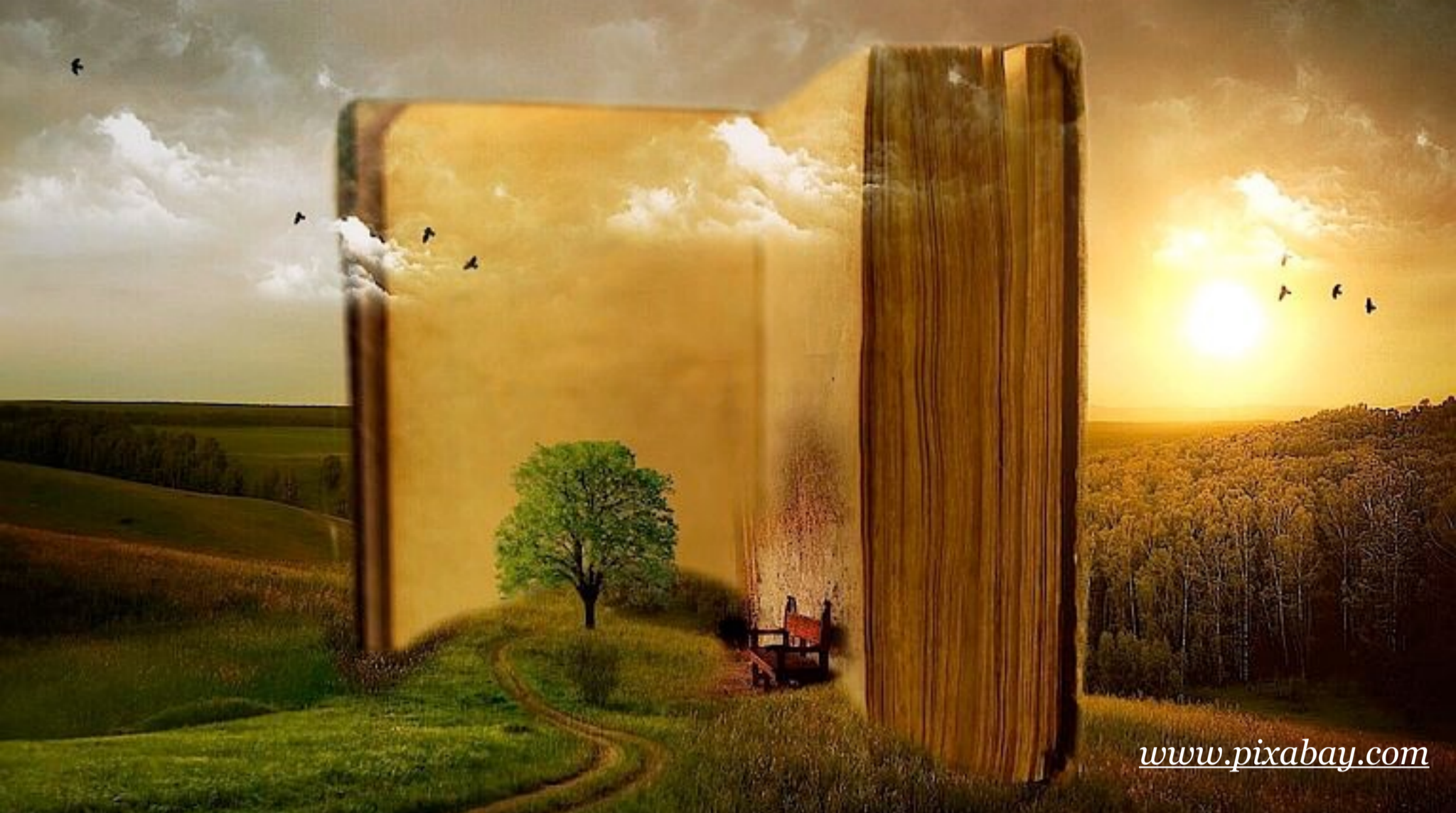
